 - Manage software products including but not limited to incorporating new version releases and customization of the product for office standards and consistency of team development of client documents and deliverables
 - Manage the implementation of supporting software for BIM
 - Evaluate new BIM related software and technologies
 - Stay informed on best practices for use of Revit (and AutoCAD) Architecture
